

Psychoeducational Assessment Quote

Purpose: A psychoeducational assessment identifies areas of strength and weakness in a student's learning profile and provides a deeper understanding of their cognitive abilities. It can also identify disorders that interfere with learning, such as Intellectual Disabilities, Specific Learning Disorders (Dyslexia, Dysgraphia, Dyscalculia), Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD), Anxiety, and Depression.

Fee: The recommended fee schedule for psychologists in Saskatchewan is approximately \$200.00, as recommended by the Psychology Association of Saskatchewan (PAS). Typically, 10-20 hours of work is involved in a psychoeducational assessment. Based on this information, **a flat fee of \$2000.00 is charged for each evaluation.** Psychological assessments are exempt from PST and GST.

The hourly breakdown is as follows:

- File Review (school records/documents, developmental history) – 2 hours
- Direct Assessment (cognitive and academic testing, clinical interview) – 4 hours
- Scoring and Interpretation – 2 hours
- Preparation of Assessment report – 2 hours
